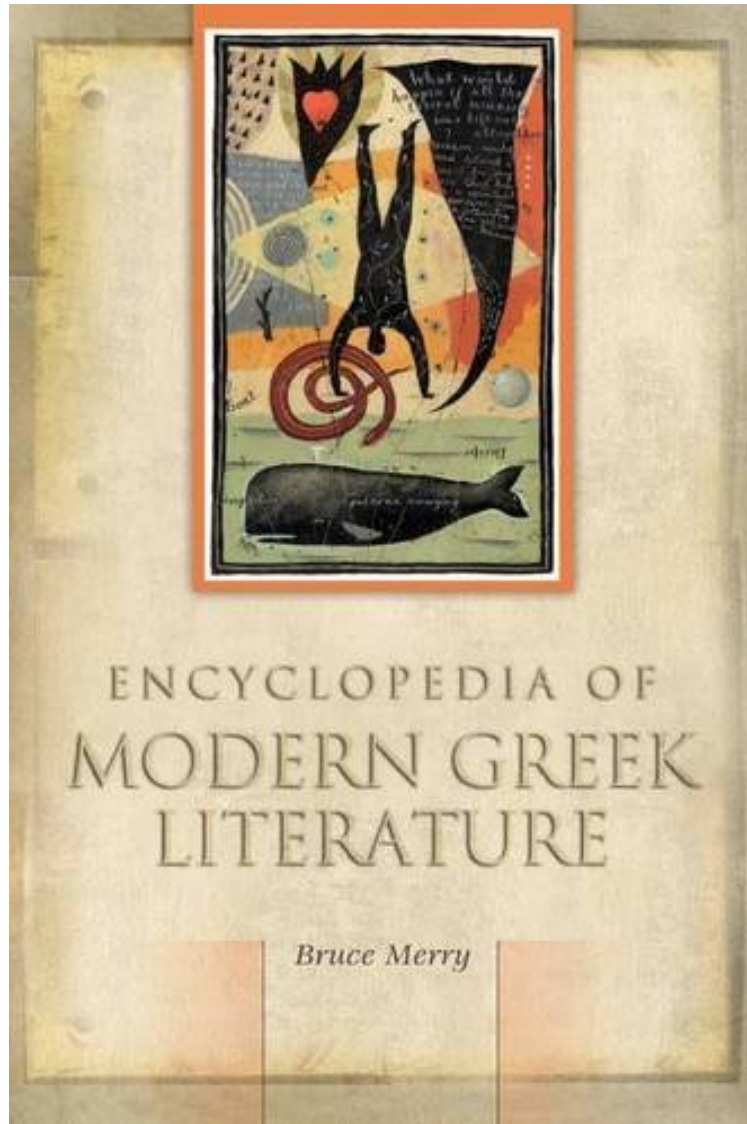

Bruce Merry's Encyclopedia of Modern Greek Literature, a comprehensive reference, with a detailed subject index and 800 entries, puts an end to that. Merry has collected centuries of worthy titles from the Byzantine era to the present, including a handful of popular modern

writers, Cavafy and Kazantzakis along with the noteworthy Nobel Prize winners Elytis and Seferis. Most entries conclude with bibliographies and further information sources. For literary scholars and average readers, this is a rich source of elegant documentation of a little known body of World Literature. What a treasure!
