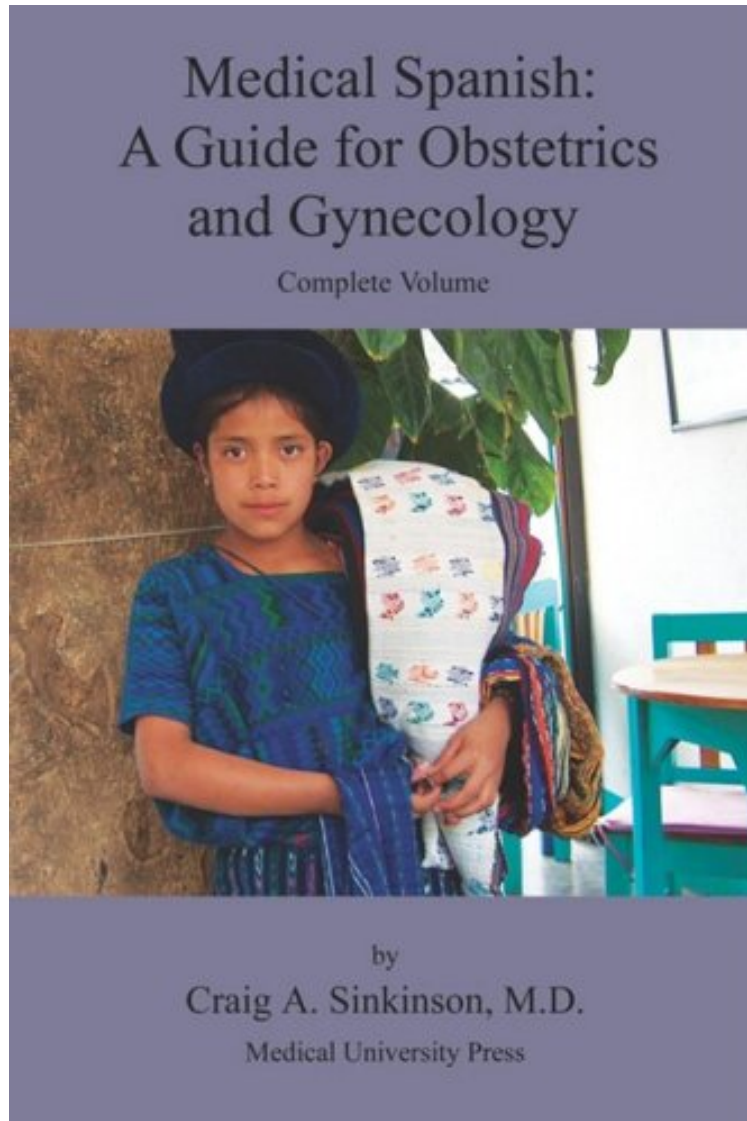

3 of 3 people found the following review helpful. A little difficult to review as I had to put aside what I want from a book like this By Jackie-the-Greyhound and just deal with what is there. Overall, this is a useful book and acceptable as

an adjunct to other resources. It starts off with phrases for the chief complaint (including modifying factors which is nice), medical history taking, social history, review of systems and physical exam (full body). There is a small section for common procedures (blood draw, IV placement, urine sample --including for a male?!?!). Diagnostic definitions and phrases follow, then words for anatomy, days, jobs, food, measurements, months, numbers, and much more. There is a section on verbs/verb tenses and then finally the specific Ob/Gyn topics. These range from birth control, breast cancer, cesarean section, hysterectomy, ovarian cancer, pelvic support, pregnancy loss, fibroids and much more. I had expected, by the product description, that there would be a better emphasis on the OB/GYN topics. For example under the hysterectomy topic one of the dozen or so statements was a translation of "before having a hysterectomy it is important to discuss other treatments with your doctor". That is true and an innocuous phrase. Unfortunately the other phrases don't go into much more detail. A superficial set of statements is pretty typical for the topics. I had hoped to be able to use this book for more detailed explanations and/or counseling, but this is not the case. There is also nothing much of use for the actual delivering of a baby such as positioning, emergency situations and what not. The section on 'childbirth' is a most cursory set of phrases that would not sufficiently describe the events for a patient. Though I had sincerely (based on the description) anticipated that this book would prove useful in the details it did not. It DOES do a decent job covering the basics and the routine and can suffice as a good resource for establishing routine phrases and for basic learning. I can certainly use this to create some specific templates in conjunction with other books. I can not see this as being of much use during an actual encounter...too much flipping around would be needed. So, for my expectations really a 2.5 star, for being useful anyway, I do bump it up to 4 stars. It is just not going to be great as a sole reference and is definitely not sufficient for anything of complexity. Grudgingly, 4 stars. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
